



Art imitates life: One of Suzy Abrahams paintings of Hampton Court Palace

Glimpsing inspiration at the palace

A stroll by the Thames led an artist to create a collection of paintings inspired by Hampton Court Palace.

Suzy Abrahams, a resident artist at the Fountain Gallery in East Molesey, has created the Glimpses collection after being “overtaken with inspiration”.

“I became mesmerised by

the gardens and found myself returning again and again, to observe different light and seasonal changes, always finding new inspiration,” she said.

The pieces, all 3sq ft acrylic and mixed media paintings, each took between two and four weeks to complete and Suzy used sand to add depth,

texture and individuality to the collection.

The exhibition is at the Fountain Gallery, Bridge Road, East Molesey from May 13 to May 25 and entrance is free.
