Suzy's Gaudi inspiration

Helen Taylor looks at some of the shows and exhibitions coming up

Artist Suzy Abrahams was so inspired by architect Anton Gaudi's controversial Park Guell in Barcelona that she has produced a collection of paintings and been invited to exhibit them in a one-woman show at the Fountain Gallery in Bridge Road, East Molesey.

The exhibition *Barcelona and Beyond* will run from Tuesday September 5 to Sunday September 17.

The undulating serpentine bench in the park, entirely constructed of colourful fragmented ceramic decorations, provides the starting point for Suzy's collection. Her paintings are arranged on canvases in vibrant compositions using vivid colours.

Suzy says: "I was overwhelmed by Gaudi's unlimited imagination. He was a genius and his projects were way ahead of his time."

The exhibition is at Fountain Gallery, 26 Bridge Road, East Molesey, from Tuesdays to Thursdays and Sundays at 11-5.30pm and Fridays and Saturdays from 10-5.30pm (not open Mondays). 020 8941 5865.
