## Exhibition of the month

– Glimpses: Hampton Court Palace Gardens

STEEPED in history, Hampton Court is undoubtedly one of the best-loved buildings in the county.

For a fresh new view of this world-famous palace and its beautiful grounds, don't miss the upcoming exhibition at the Fountain Gallery in East Molesey called *Glimpses: Hampton Court Palace Gardens*.

Showcasing a series of striking works by artist Suzy Abrahams, a Goldsmiths' graduate and former graphic designer, her 'glimpses' of the palace are recorded in a series of dramatic, 3ft square acrylic and

mixed media paintings. She also came up with the innovative idea of photographing her completed work against the backdrop of the palace.

"I became mesmerised by the gardens and found myself returning again and again to observe the different light and seasonal changes, always finding new inspiration," says Suzy.

Located just across the bridge from Hampton Court, the Fountain Gallery is nestled in a delightful shopping street famous for its antiques, cafés and
