

Inspirational gardens

PAINTINGS of Hampton Court Palace gardens will go on display at a gallery in Molesey this month.

The works by Suzy Abrahams, a former graphic designer, are open to public viewing at The Fountain Gallery, just a stone's throw away from the palace, in Bridge Street.

Suzy, from Croydon, was walking along the river near the palace in September last year, when she spotted the gardens and felt a huge desire to paint them.

The 48-year-old said: "I became mesmerised by the gardens and found myself returning again and again, to observe different light and seasonal changes, always finding new inspiration."

Suzy, who is one of 18 member artists at The Fountain, will display 10 paintings between May 1 and 25.

Admission is free.
